**Sacrament of Reconciliation 30 minutes prior to Mass or by appointment**

**Reflection:** A Communion of Hearts. To love people as Jesus loves them is to wash their feet, to serve them in humility; it is to help them rise up in truth and love. Here Jesus is revealing something more: to love is to lay down one's life for others, to place their interests before our own. It is to give them life. That can mean accepting difficulties, danger and even death so that they may live and grow in love. To love is to live in communion with others, to transmit to them the life and love of Jesus. It is to reveal to them that they are loved, loved by Jesus. In this way we become their friend because we are a friend of Jesus. In this friendship nothing is hidden or secret. Jesus has shared everything he has heard from the Father all is given. The barriers that separated the finite from the Infinite, the temporal from the eternal, the human from the divine, have disappeared. At times it is necessary for us to live an austere life, like John the Baptizer, and to seek a certain separation from our bodies, to strain to reach God through our efforts. But God has appeared in the flesh, has become vulnerable in the flesh. He has come to offer us his friendship, to invite us to become his beloved. He has become little and vulnerable, to live a communion of hearts with us and to join him in giving life to others. ~Jean Vanier
