Reflection: At Home in the Upper Room Hair opened on Broadway the month I turned sixteen. According to its exuberant lyrics, we had just entered a new stage of human development, one marked by “sympathy and trust abounding” in place of “falsehoods or derision.” What awaited those brave enough to shuck off stifling social norms and wholeheartedly embrace life was nothing less than “mystic crystal revelation.”

Twenty-five years later, still woefully unenlightened, I made my first retreat at a contemplative Catholic hermitage. At predawn Vigils, the monks bent forward at the waist, chanting a strange phrase: “Praise the Father, the Word, and the Spirit, the three who are one in heaven / by the Spirit, the Water and the Blood, we are saved and share in their life” (see 1 John 5:6-9).

In the decades since, I have learned from the monks that—unlike the magical transformation promised in the “Age of Aquarius”—conversion of life does not come easy. And “enlightenment” feels more like a new and improved pair of glasses than it does a mystical experience. We set off behind a Water-Bearer, following him bewilderedly down unfamiliar passageways, arriving finally at an unknown destination in a neighborhood we’ve never been before.

But once we climb the stairs to the Upper Room, we realize where we are: finally at home with God where we belong. And thanks to the Spirit, the Water, and the Blood, we can stay and share in this divine life. Paula Huston
