Today's gospel reading portrays the virtue of humility. In ordinary life, people try to show their worth through the display of their wealth and by advertising the position they occupy in society. For Jesus however, self-worth and respect should be earned by the manner in which we carry ourselves but not through the display of wealth and the position we occupy. The best and the most appropriate way by which we earn respect is living a life of humility. God resists the proud and gives grace to the humble (Jas.4:6). The humility demanded of us should be inherent and not faked out only to attract the attention and sympathy of others. We are therefore cautioned not to seek what is too sublime for us, neither should we search into things beyond our strength; for these will constitute self-exaltation, "Everyone who exalts himself will be humbled but the one who humbles himself will be exalted (Lk. 14:11). -Father Emmanuel
