The purpose of the Mass is to help us hear Jesus, see Jesus, receive Jesus, and serve Jesus. This description isn't exhaustive, but we can use it to reflect on today's Gospel Reading. This two-fold Mystery—of God's Word, and God's Word made Flesh—is what St. Luke proclaims to us in today's Gospel Reading. The two disciples, who symbolize you and me, are on the way to Emmaus. They are caught unaware by this man with whom they converse. At first they don't recognize him. But as they hear him, their hearts burn with passion for God through Sacred Scripture. After a long journey, they recognize Jesus in what St. Luke the Evangelist calls *"the breaking of bread"*, a phrase Luke uses throughout his other book of the Bible—*Acts of the Apostles*—to refer to the Holy Eucharist. – Father Thomas Hoisington
