## 34<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time

Living a life of truth in Christ implies being at peace with one another and rendering service to our neighbors in humility. This life of truth consists of loving our neighbors, being able to forgive one another, and being ready to reconcile with one another in Christ Jesus, who has dominion over our lives. Their misery had turned into joy after they had allowed Jesus to use their boat. They caught a lot of fish. All that Peter had to do was to say "Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets." (Lk. 5:5)**

As we celebrate his kingship today, Jesus is inviting us to surrender our life's boat to him to be used. Let us accept him as the king of our lives and let him direct us to live our lives according to his grace, and we will surely harvest the goodness of the Lord. —*Father Emmanuel*
