Reflection: In This World and the Next In cahoots. It's what my dad accused us of being when we set him in a card game. It happened rarely, so being in cahoots was something we were proud of. But not too proud, more luck than skill behind the outcome. Even a blind squirrel finds a nut once in a while. A pair of blind squirrels, the blind leading the blind . . . the outcome was nonetheless cause for rejoicing. Until the next hand was dealt. And the next and the next. In pairs. It's how Jesus sent out the seventy-two. Sometimes they had to be in cahoots too, lambs among wolves that they were. The hand they were dealt? No less than the Kingdom of God that was at hand. The Kingdom of God is still at hand, and it is entrusted to each and every one of us. Sent out together, gifted and skilled beyond measure. "Peace," we say as we proclaim the Kingdom. And a short list is not an outcome to rejoice over, whether on earth or in the heavenly roster. So Jesus sends us out in pairs. Together, we set out.
